Dear Parents / Carers

Thank you to all the parents who were able to attend the Zoom meeting on Wednesday evening. I hope you found it informative and it whetted the children's appetites for what is in store at Grosvenor Hall. In order to secure your child's place on the trip, a non-refundable deposit of £50 is required by Friday 7th May. All payments should be made through your ParentMail account. Please note that by paying this deposit you are giving your consent for your child to attend the residential visit to Grosvenor Hall from 20th to 24th September 2021.

You are free to make subsequent payments as and when you are able and ParentMail will be set up to accept payments in multiples of £10. We would appreciate it if the total amount of £250 is paid before the children undertake the visit. Our suggested payment schedule is as follows:

- £50 by 1st June 2021
- £50 by 1st July 2021
- £50 by 1st August 2021
- Final £50 by 1st September 2021

If you are experiencing difficulties in meeting the cost of this trip, please do not hesitate to speak to me, Jo White or Mrs Atkinson in the school office. We would not wish any child to miss out on the trip due to potential financial hardship.

This is an amazing opportunity for your child to participate in many adventurous activities in a safe and secure environment at an incredibly reasonable price.

We will be arranging a meeting in Term 6, closer to the trip, to present to you in more detail the exciting range of activities available at Grosvenor Hall and the items the children will need to take with them.
