

Maths

Through our Mastering Number sessions, we continue to deepen the children's understanding of numbers to 10. This term we will practise counting verbally to 20 (and beyond), exploring the composition of numbers to 10, subitising amounts to 5, comparing and ordering numbers to 10. We will also explore number bonds to 5 and 10.

Physical Development

In PE we start gymnastics. The children will learn to create and hold different body shapes, stretch, curl, balance and travel on different apparatus.

We will continue to use a range of large and small equipment to develop their gross and fine motor skills during child-initiated sessions.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will continue to focus on developing independence in the setting, building resilience and a positive mindset.

Our PSHE theme is 'Relationships'. We will be learning about being a good friend as well as solving problems and staying friends. As we go through the topic, we will develop an understanding of how our words can make people feel and we explore the impact that both kind and unkind words can have on our friends.

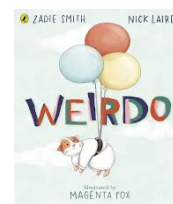
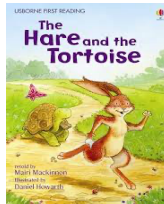
Chestnut Class Curriculum Map

Communication and Language

We will continue to build an interest and love of books through our Power of Reading sessions and a daily story time. Our sessions will introduce new vocabulary and provide opportunities for the children to use the new vocabulary through role play and speaking and listening activities.

As our topic explores different aspects of sport so too will our focused books. This term we will read and explore. . .

Understanding of the World.



This term the children have chosen to learn all about sport. We will start by learning about the different types of sport and equipment used. Our learning will continue by exploring sport around the world as well as finding out about different sporting heroes. We will have the opportunity to try out a range of activities and find out about the effect of sport on our bodies. It really does promise to be an exciting topic and we can't wait to get started!



Literacy

Using the Read, Write, Inc scheme we will continue to learn sounds, including 'special friends', from Speed sound Set 2. We will practise blending for reading and segmenting for writing using sounds from set 1. We will begin to read and write CCVC and CVCC words.

Through shared reading we will introduce new vocabulary, ask questions and encourage the children to make predictions and sequence the stories.

This term we are having a real focus on forming letters using the correct formation.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be provided with a range of media to express themselves. This will include art and craft activities, role play, building and music. Children will be encouraged to explore colour, sound, texture form and function as well as beginning to plan, make and then review their own creations.
