

Mathematics

Shape – We will learn about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Money – We will work with pounds, pence and notes, and towards the end of the unit they will work with pounds and pence together.

Multiplication and division – We will be learning about skip counting, equal groups, times tables, multiplication sentences and scaling problems. Also, we will learn two methods of division (grouping and sharing), and how to calculate using these two different strategies.

Length and height – We will learn to measure using simple standard units and scales.

English

The purpose of these books is to engage the children in high quality texts, where we will explore the narrative and characters in detail.
