Maths

- Draw and label as many 2D and 3D shapes as you can.

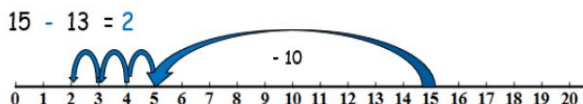
2D - write how many sides and vertices each shape has.
