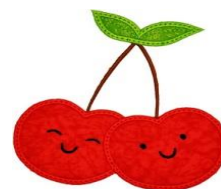


Cherry Class Home Learning

Term 1



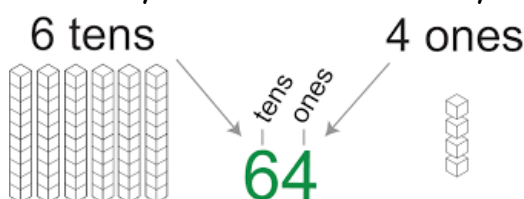
The most important home learning you can do is to read. Make sure you are reading everyday, this can be your reading book or any book you have at home.

Completing a short maths activity each day will also help your child to make good progress.

This could be on Mathletics or online games such as Top Marks.

Maths

- Practise counting to 100.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Order these numbers 17, 64, 56, 8
How many tens and ones do they have?



- Memorise the number pairs to 10
0-10, 1-9, 2-8, 3-7, 4-6, 5-5.
Use your fingers to help you.



Use these to find and remember number pairs to 20.

Science Living things and their habitats

- Draw a habitat you can find in West Malling (or local area), including the animals and plants that live there.
- You could write fact sentences about it as well.

English

- Make sure you can spell all of the Year 1 words on their own and in sentences. (You can find these on the class page)
- Write a list of adjectives to describe yourself.
- Draw a picture and write sentences about yourself. When writing continue to practise the key writing skills of using capital letters, full stops and leaving spaces between words.



Geography - Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold climate?

- Choose a country and explore whether it has a hot or cold climate.
