It is vital to practise these key skills every day to help your child to make good progress. This may include Mathletics, practical activities/games or practising the year 1 spellings. Reading Books

Children will be bringing home a reading book every Friday. Please keep these at home to read until the following Thursday when they will need to be brought back into school to be changed. It may be helpful if children could bring a book bag or small rucksack with them so that the reading books can be easily transported between home and school.

Please remember that there should be no sweets, chocolate bars or nut products in lunch boxes. Can all children please have a separate drink for their packed lunch to prevent any lost or forgotten water bottles and from a safety aspect because the classroom is unattended during the lunch hour. Children can have a soft drink/squash/fruit shoot as part of their lunch should they wish.
