Science During term 3 we will be looking at electricity in Science. Research Sir Michael Stanley Whittingham (born 22 December 1941) who is a British-American chemist. Create a fact file about him. Please include pictures, full sentences and subheadings.	15 th January
Geography In class you have learnt about what life is like now living in the Amazon. You know that Indigenous people live in the Amazon today - choose your own way to explain what life is like for these people and how their life is different to yours. (leaflet/fact file/ double page spread).	22 nd January
History - The Maya Research the Ancient Maya civilisation and produce a timeline of the significant events during this part of history. Include pictures, key dates and facts. (you may choose to produce a scroll rather than doing this directly in your home learning book).	29 th January
Politics (2-week homework) Think of a topic you are passionate about - it could be healthy eating, equal rights for all people, homelessness, food poverty etc. Once you have decided on your topic you need to research it (show this in your home learning book) and then create a speech that you will give to the class to persuade them to come around to your way of thinking - if needed produce an accompanying PowerPoint to support your speech.	12 th February
