

Mathematics

Mathematics We will begin this term by consolidating knowledge, reviewing, reinforcing and practicing skills to ensure that the children are secure in their understanding of number work and the four operations. We will look at statistics including tables, pictograms, bar charts, line graphs and pie charts and how to interpret information in them. We will review knowledge of geometry and shape including measures and angles and practice calculations with fractions, decimals and percentages. Finally, the children will participate in a range of problem-solving activities that will use all the mathematical skills they have learned throughout their time in key stage 2.

English

Resist - in this unit we will read the book Resist by Tom Palmer. We will end the unit by writing a biography all about Audrey Hepburn.

VE Day

We will be using the events of VE Day as a writing stimulus. We will be writing letters and recounts of the event.

Harry Potter

We will be using the dementors scene from Harry Potter (3) to write a piece of narrative writing including speech.

A beautiful lie

Children will engage in a longer work of fiction and to create their own extended fiction writing, based on events that could have happened in "A Beautiful Lie".

Summer Term – Year 6

RE

What does it mean to be Jewish in Britain today?

Children will make connections between this unit and their work in Year 5. Children will answer key questions from their own perspective as well as from different perspectives.

In this unit we will consider the impact that climate change is having on our planet, and we will begin to form our own opinions.

Ethiopia

In this unit we will discover what life is like in Ethiopia. We will be making comparisons between Ethiopia and the UK.

Music -

In term 5 will consolidate learning of pitch and rhythm. We will continue to build on our learning of Jazz Music and look at improvising using our voices and different classroom instruments. In term 6 we will look at vocal technique, particularly that of Musical Theatre and how to use our voices as instruments. We will also spend time learning, rehearsing and performing songs for the end of year performance.

Science

For the next two terms, our topic is Animals Including Humans. We will be looking in detail at the circulatory system, the heart and how nutrients and water are transported around the body. We will also consider diet, drugs and exercise and the impact of lifestyle choices. This topic consistently generates many questions and discussion about the human body which will all be answered at an age-appropriate level but may encourage your child to ask questions at home.
