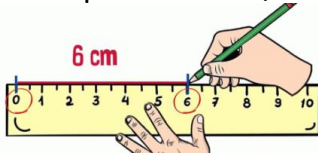
Maths

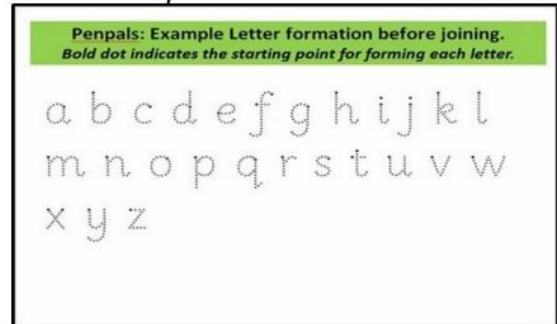
English
