

Mulberry Class Term 5 Notices

Welcome back to school, we hope you have had a lovely break!

Important:

Uniform – Please ensure that your child is coming to school in full uniform every day. **Any items of clothing** your child is bringing to school is **named**. Children should be wearing a school tie each day. Please ensure that your child is wearing **school shoes** each day.

Times Tables Rockstars – In class we will be checking the TTRS site regularly to see how far the children are progressing through the various levels of TTRS. The children are really motivated and want to achieve the best rock status possible, please encourage your child to access TTRS regularly (ideally daily) at home.

Reading – Reading has drastically improved over the past term so please try to hear your child read daily and record this in their reading record book as you have been doing. Once your child has received their gold award (60 reads) they will then start to get raffle tickets to enter the reading prize draw.

PE – PE will be on a **Monday** and **Thursday** this term. Please ensure that stud earrings are removed on PE days and that long hair is tied back. PE kit should be worn on these days (**black jogging bottoms or shorts/leggings and a plain white t-shirt/polo shirt or school PE shirt and school jumper or school PE hoodie**).

Swimming – On **Monday's** we will be going swimming at Larkfield Leisure Centre. Children will need to bring all items listed on the original letter in a **named bag**. Children should wear their **PE kits** on Monday for ease when changing.

General information:

Spellings – Children will have spellings sent home on a Wednesday which will then be tested in school each week on the following Wednesday.

Weekly homework – This will be set at the beginning of the term. There will be a different activity for each week. Children can earn up to 10 castle points on their home learning: up to 5 points for presentation and 5 points for content.
