Expectations of Home Learning:

Reading - As part of the RALF initiative, children should read EVERY day. Please continue to use the tracking system in the back of the Home Learning books and bring these into school on Wednesday. Every time your child reads, they will earn points towards their RALF certificates and raffle tickets.

Maths - Please use Mathletics and Times Table Rockstars regularly; the log in details can be found in the front cover of your child's Home Learning book. Times tables are incredibly important, and it is essential that all children practise these daily.

Weekly homework - This will be set at the beginning of each term. We hope that they are fun and interesting activities that will develop them as learners. Out on a Friday, in on a Wednesday. There will be a different activity for each week. Your child can earn up to 5 castle points for presentation and 5 castles points for content. There will also be Maths homework assigned once a week which will need to be completed and returned on the Wednesday along with the Home Learning books.

Useful Reminders

PE - PE will be on a Monday and Friday. Please ensure that stud earrings are removed on PE days and that long hair is tied back. PE kit should be worn on these days (black jogging bottoms or shorts and a plain white t-shirt/polo shirt or school PE shirt and school jumper or school PE hoodie).
