- Draw and label a healthy meal that you have eaten.

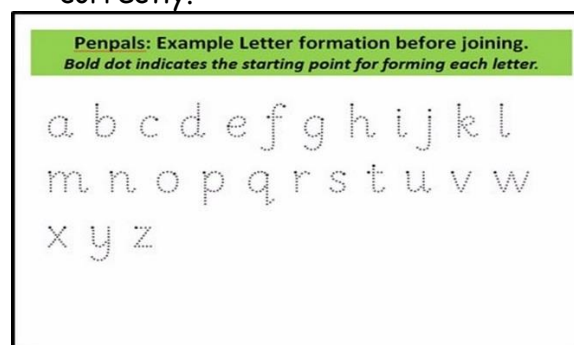
English
