



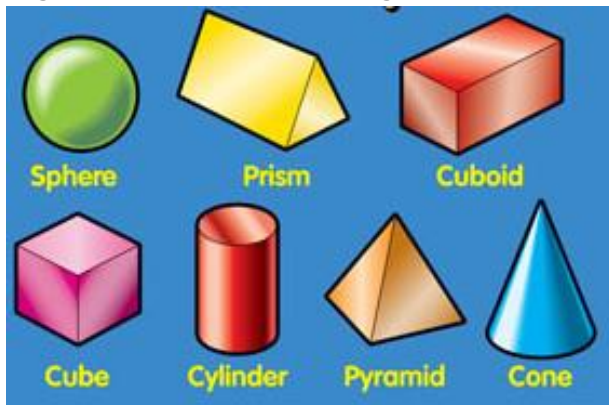
Lime Class Home Learning

Term 3



Maths

- Use objects/toys you have at home to create a subtraction number story. Can you write the subtraction number sentence to match it? (I have 8 cars, 3 drive away, how many are left? $8-3=5$. I have 6 dolls, 2 go to sleep, how many are still awake? $6-2=4$).
- Continue to practise using part whole models to create addition and subtraction number sentences.
- Practise finding 1 more and 1 less than any given number up to 20. Can you write the numbers?
- Can you find any 3D shapes in your house? Take a photo/ draw what it is. E.g., a sphere might be a ball or a cube might be a dice.



English

- Find a non-fiction (real or on Bug Club). Have a go at locating and using the contents and index pages. Read it with an adult and write a sentence to explain something that you learnt/found out.
- Practise these red words:

he, me, we, she, be, no, so, go, old, her, do.

Can you read them? Have a go at writing them either as a list or in a sentence - We can go and play. Do you like her hat?

- Practise writing the letters of the alphabet as capitals and lower case.

Science- Animals

- What is your favourite animal? What animal group does it belong to? Is it a bird, mammal, fish, reptile, or amphibian?
- Find out what animals are carnivores, herbivores, or omnivores. Draw or write the animal names for each one.

Geography- Africa

- Can you name the 7 different continents?
- Use an online map or an atlas/globe to find Kenya. What continent is it in? Can you find out a fact about Kenya? (E.g., what language they speak, what animals you would find there or sights you might see).
