



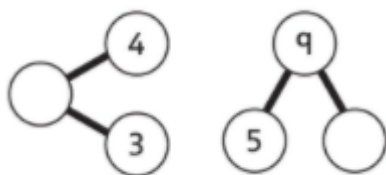
Lime Class Home Learning

Maths

- Continue to practise writing numbers 1-20 correctly. Please help your child to write these numbers correctly. (You could use paints, chalk, pens).
- Practise number bonds to 10. What goes with 6 to make 10? What goes with 2 to make 10? (Use fingers to help!)
- Can you find a rectangle, circle, square or triangle in your house? Take a photo/ draw what it is. E.g. a rectangle might be a dinner place mat or a circle might be a clock.
- Can you fill in these part whole models?



- Practise logging into Mathletics independently.

English

- Create a character description of any fairy tale character - What do they look like? How do they feel? What do they do?

- Practise these red words:

I, the, you, your, said, was, are, of, want, what, they, to.

Can you read them? Have a go at writing them either as a list or in a sentence - I want to play. They are at the zoo.

- Learn the letter names of the letters in the alphabet.
- Practise logging into Bug Club independently.

RE

- Make a model of a nativity scene or re-tell the Christmas story.



Science- Materials

- Find different objects around the house. What material is the object made from? Can you describe what the material is like? (soft, hard, smooth, rough, stretchy, transparent).

History- West Malling

- Take a walk down West Malling High Street and see if you can spot any historical buildings.
- On your walk, can you find any 'blue plaques' of famous people who used to live or work in West Malling?
