

Mathematics

Number: place value

We will be reading, writing and ordering numbers to 20. Children will be learning to recognise numbers in the written word as well.

We will be finding the numbers one more and one less than any given number.

We will be learning to identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least

Number: addition and subtraction:

Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10.

English

Our Power of Reading books this term are:

- Here We Are by Oliver Jeffers
- Rapunzel by Bethan Woolvin

Please do not read these books to your child as it will spoil their experiences during English lessons.

These high-quality books will engage the children and enable us to explore the characters and narratives in detail. We will be writing for a range of purposes, including rhymes, songs, labels, captions, and instructions.

We will be refreshing our phonic knowledge and building on this.

We will be learning about question and exclamation marks.

Autumn Term – Year 1

RE

God – We will be thinking about what Christians believe God is like by looking at some Bible stories. Incarnation – we will be looking at the story of Jesus' birth and thinking about why Christmas matters to Christians.

Music

We will explore making different pitches and sounds with our voices in Term 1. In Term 2 we will be creating long and short sounds on simple untuned percussion instruments.

History

We will be learning about the history of West Malling and finding out about St Leonards Tower, the Church and the Abbey.

Geography

We will learn to locate the 7 continents and 5 oceans. We will also locate the hot and cold areas of the world while using maps, atlases and aerial photographs.

R(S)HE

We will focus on two topics – 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Differences.' We will be learning about what makes us special and how we are all different and unique.

Science

Over the year we will be looking at seasonal changes. This term we will be setting up investigations on temperature, wind speed, rain fall etc. We will then come back to these investigations throughout the school year.

Materials - we will be looking at the properties and uses of various materials. We will be carrying out various investigations to test different materials for particular purposes.

Art

We will be learning to mix and paint with secondary colours, using circles to create abstract art and working collaboratively to create a piece of art inspired by water.

DT

Textiles – To explore different ways of joining fabrics before creating hand puppets. We will develop technical skills of cutting, glueing, stapling and pinning.

Computing

The children will be learning how to use a programmable toy (Bee-Bot). We are digital artists – to create artwork in a range of styles on iPads.

PE – Each week we will have an indoor and outdoor PE session.

Term 1 – Gymnastics – travelling and balancing in different ways.

Term 1 – Multi Skills – take part in a range of jumping, running and throwing and catching activities.

Term 2 – Sending & Receiving (hands) –using different balls.
