

Mathematics

Fractions - This unit introduces fractions for the first time. It builds on children's knowledge of equal parts, which they have come across in previous units about multiplication and division.

Positions and Directions - This unit focuses on describing position in relation to other objects.

Problem solving and efficient methods - This unit brings together the key ideas of number that have been addressed in previous units and provides an opportunity for children to practise all four operations.

Time - This unit will develop children's ability to tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past and to the hour.

Weight, Volume and Temperature - This unit focuses on children accurately measuring mass, volume, capacity, and temperature.

English

We will be reading the Power of Reading books:

- Hummingbird by Nicola Davies
- The Hodgeheg by Dick King-Smith

The purpose of these books is to engage the children in high quality texts where we will explore the narrative and characters in detail.

Additionally, we will write about these books using a range of genres.

SPaG

We will be learning about how suffixes are added to the end of root words.

RE

In the Summer term we be exploring the following big questions 'Who is Muslim and what do they believe?'

Through these questions we will deepen our understanding of Islam.

Music

We will explore how our bodies and voices can be used to make music for different effects and they will work on responding to music, moving in time to varied rhythms.

History

Stone Age - Children will find out about how their ancestors lived and eventually settled during this time.
