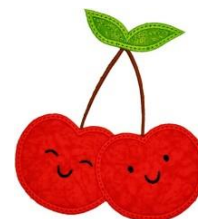


Cherry Class Home Learning

Term 3



Maths

- Practise the times tables we have learnt, the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Start by skip counting e.g. 2 4 6 8 10 12. If you are already confident, challenge yourself to learn the 3s and 4s too. It will help to practise writing them out.
- Have a go at cutting fruit into halves and quarters. Make sure they are in equal parts! Then have a go at halving and quartering amounts. For example, 4 grapes shared by 2. Can you write the related division sentence?
- Have a look at a digital and analogue clock. Practice telling the time to o'clock and half past.
- Keep practising adding 2 digit numbers. Either by drawing tens and ones, or using the column method.
