The Iron man

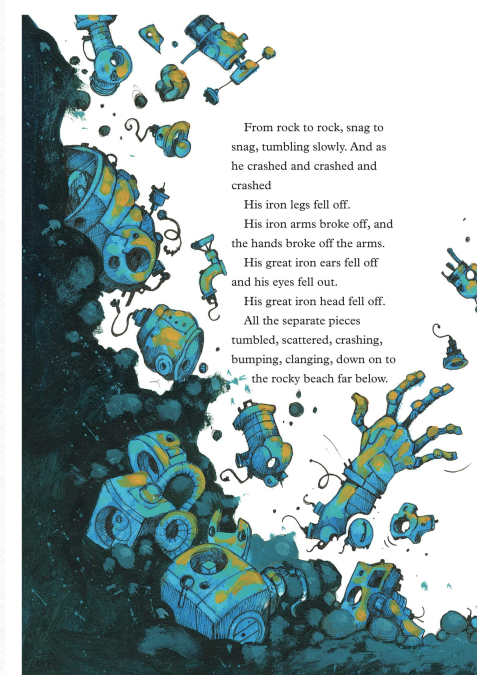
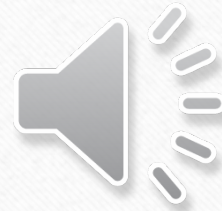
The Iron Man by Ted Hughes

I ran and told my mum and Dad got a gun.



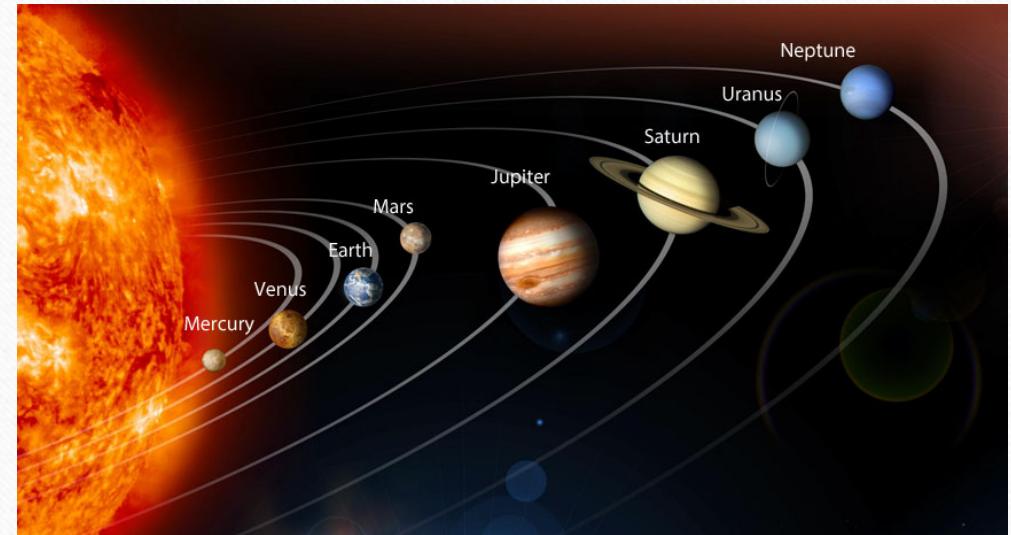


Science

- The planets are Mercury, Venus, Earth, Jupiter, Mars, Saturn, Neptune and Uranus.





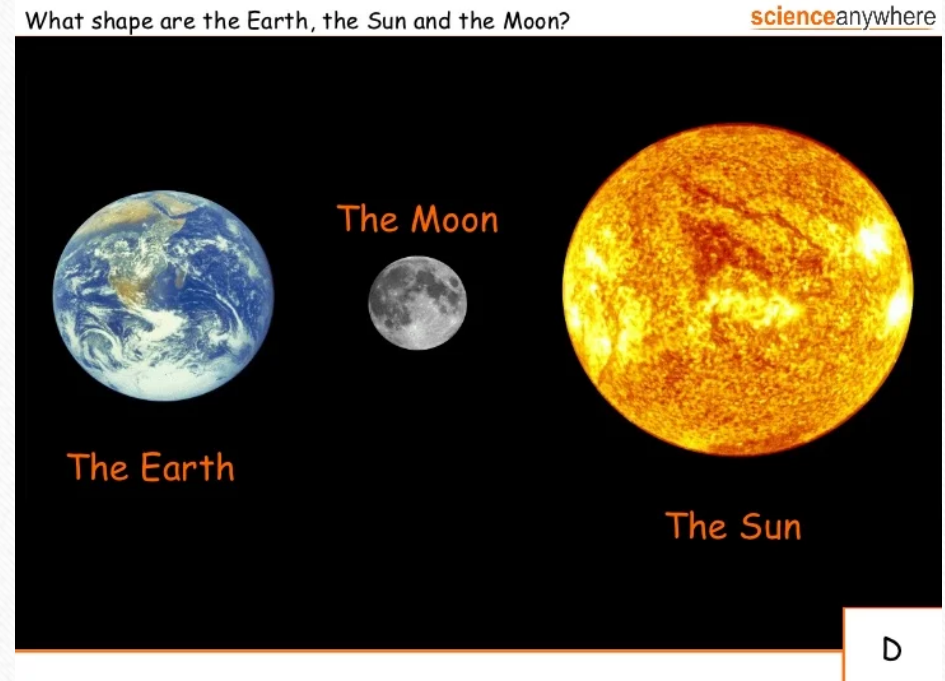
Why do we get day and night?

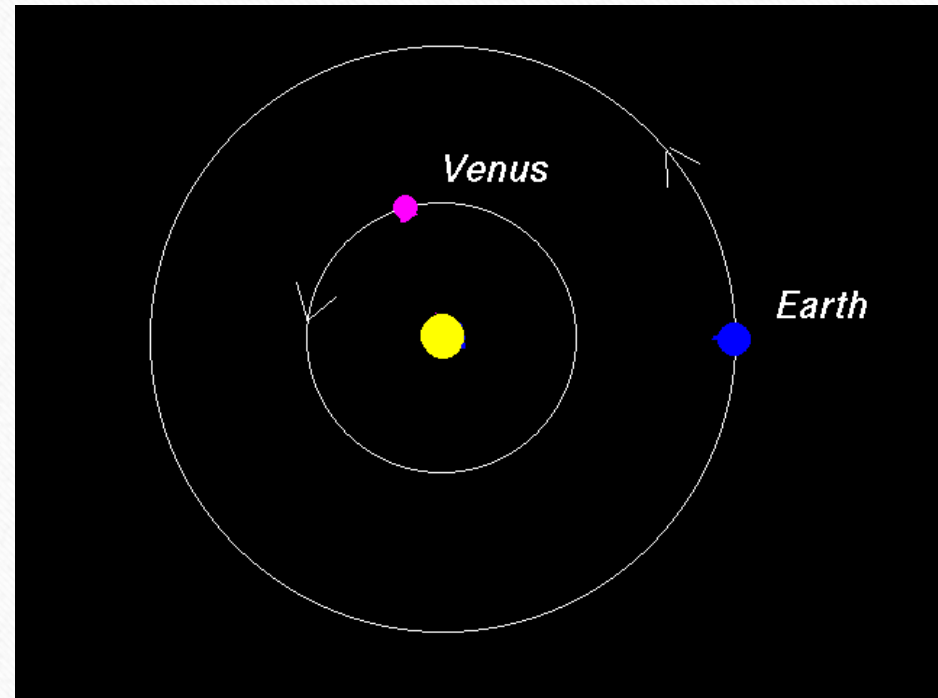
What shape are the earth moon and sun
