



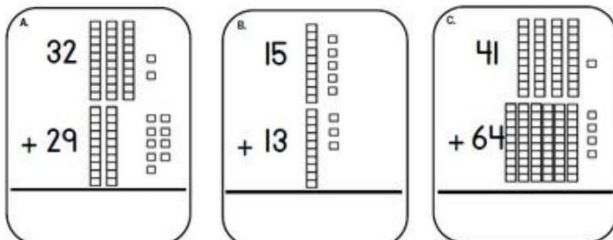

Maths

- Tick-tock! Keep practising telling the time on either an analogue or digital clock. It would be a great idea to start wearing a simple watch.
- Keep practising your 2, 5 and 10 times tables. When you are confident, keep challenging yourself. The order we teach times tables are 10, 2, 5, 3, 4, 8, 6, 9, 11, 12.
Make sure you can recall the related division facts too.
Eg. $2 \times 10 = 20$ $20 \div 10 = 2$
(lots of) (grouped into)
- Challenge yourself to do some tricky addition and subtraction problems. Draw base 10 or use the column method.



English

- If you can, visit the library and choose a story. Firstly, enjoy reading the story. Then think about what you like and dislike about the story.
- Our book is based in a garden, write some interesting sentences about your garden. Use the conjunctions 'and', 'so', 'but' to join two ideas together. Use 'because', 'so', 'when', 'if' to explain your ideas.
- Create some silly sentences using the Yr2 red words. You can find these on the website and should be able to read and spell them all by the end of the year. I have also added the Yr3/4 words if you need a challenge.



For example:

The **beautiful children** walked in the **wild grass**. **Mr** and **Mrs Christmas** **love** to **improve** their festive **clothes**.

Science - Animals

- If you could have any animal in the world as a pet, what would you choose? Write about why you would love to care for this animal.
- Caring for animals is hard work, write about all the things a zookeeper would need to do every day.



Geography- Wonderful weather

- Keep a weather diary over 5 days. Record the weather in the morning, afternoon and evening. Describe the patterns you can see.
- Keeping safe in the sun is very important. Make a poster explaining how to keep safe in the sun.
