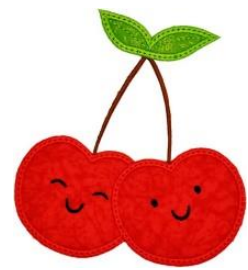




Cherry Class Home Learning

Maths

- Keep practising the times tables you know. You should all know how to work out the 2, 5 and 10 times tables by counting up.
E.g. $4 \times 5 = 5, 10, 15, 20$
 $6 \times 2 = 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12$

Remember that we say groups of instead of times.

If you have mastered this have a go at other times tables.

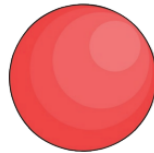
- How many real life objects can you find of each of these 3D shapes.



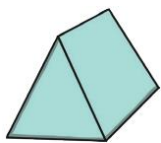
cube



cylinder



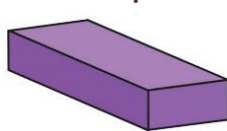
sphere



triangular prism



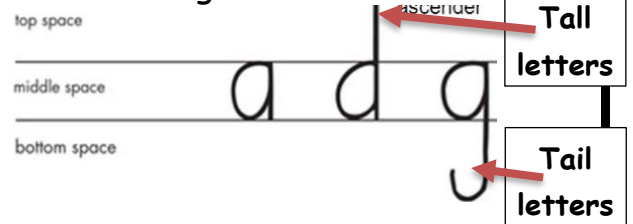
cone
