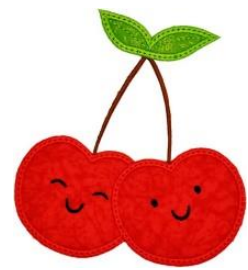

Maths

- Complete these questions. Draw tens and ones to help you.

$$24 + 31$$



$$\begin{array}{ll} 24 + 32 = & 25 - 13 = \\ 36 + 24 = & 32 - 13 = \\ 28 + 23 = & 35 - 17 = \\ 29 + 29 = & 42 - 15 = \end{array}$$

- Add and subtract 10 to these numbers. 7, 23, 54, 83, 99
Look at a 100 square to help you.
- Memorise the number pairs to 20
0-20, 1-19, 2-18, 3-17, 4-16, 5-15, 6-14, 7-13, 8-12, 9-11, 10-10.
Write them out and ask a grown up to quiz you!
You might want to create a game to help you to learn them.

Geography- West Malling

- Draw and label a picture of your favourite place in West Malling. Write sentences to explain why you love it there.
- Make a list of as many different shops as you can think of in West Malling. Do you know what you can buy and do in each one?

English
