



Procedure for Entrance to Secondary Education (PESE) 2027

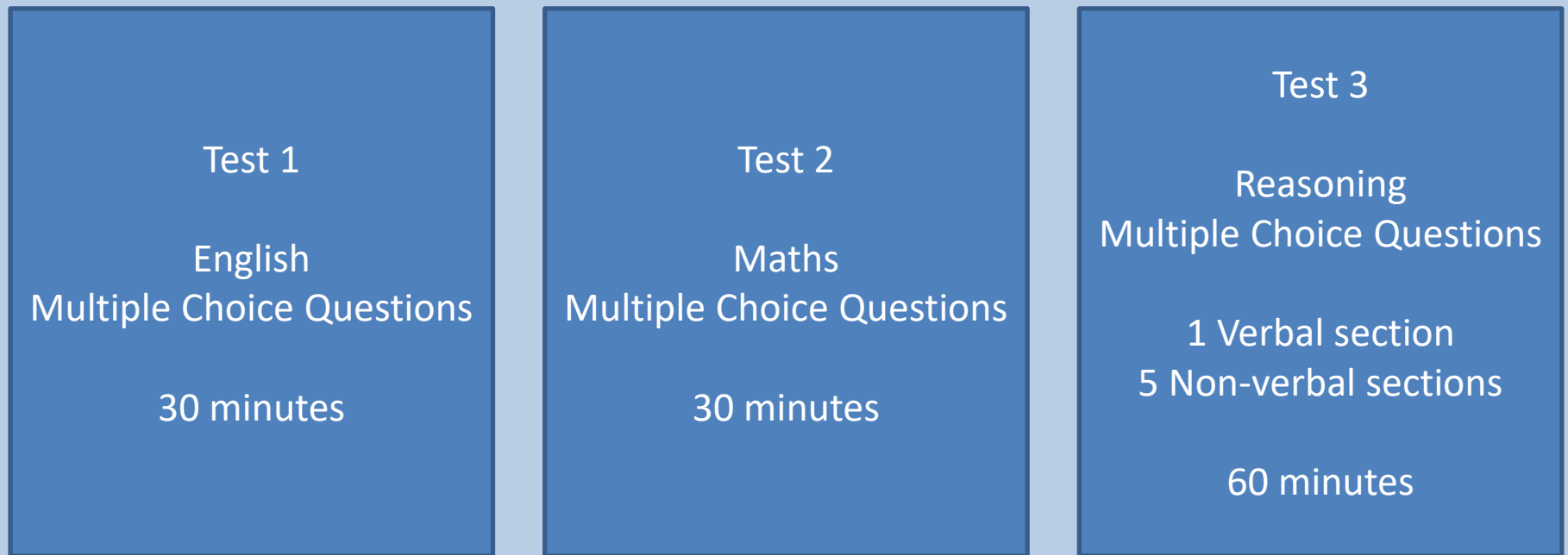
A presentation on how PESE works
and advice for interested parents

What is PESE?

- It is the grammar school assessment for Kent
- **Any Y5 pupil in school who is interested in a Kent grammar school place for September 2027 MUST register for testing by 1 July 2026 to take part in the September tests. This includes children with an EHC Plan. Registration opened on 1 June 2026.**
- Parents should register their child online, by visiting www.kent.gov.uk/kenttest and creating an online account. Once you have completed and submitted the registration you should get a confirmation email.
- If you would like your child to sit the PESE test, but believe they have a disability or SEN which will affect their access to testing, please come and discuss this with Mr Rye ***before registering them***, as we may be able to apply for additional access arrangements.

How does it work?

- Once you have applied, the children sit the tests on Thursday, September 10th (second week of term).

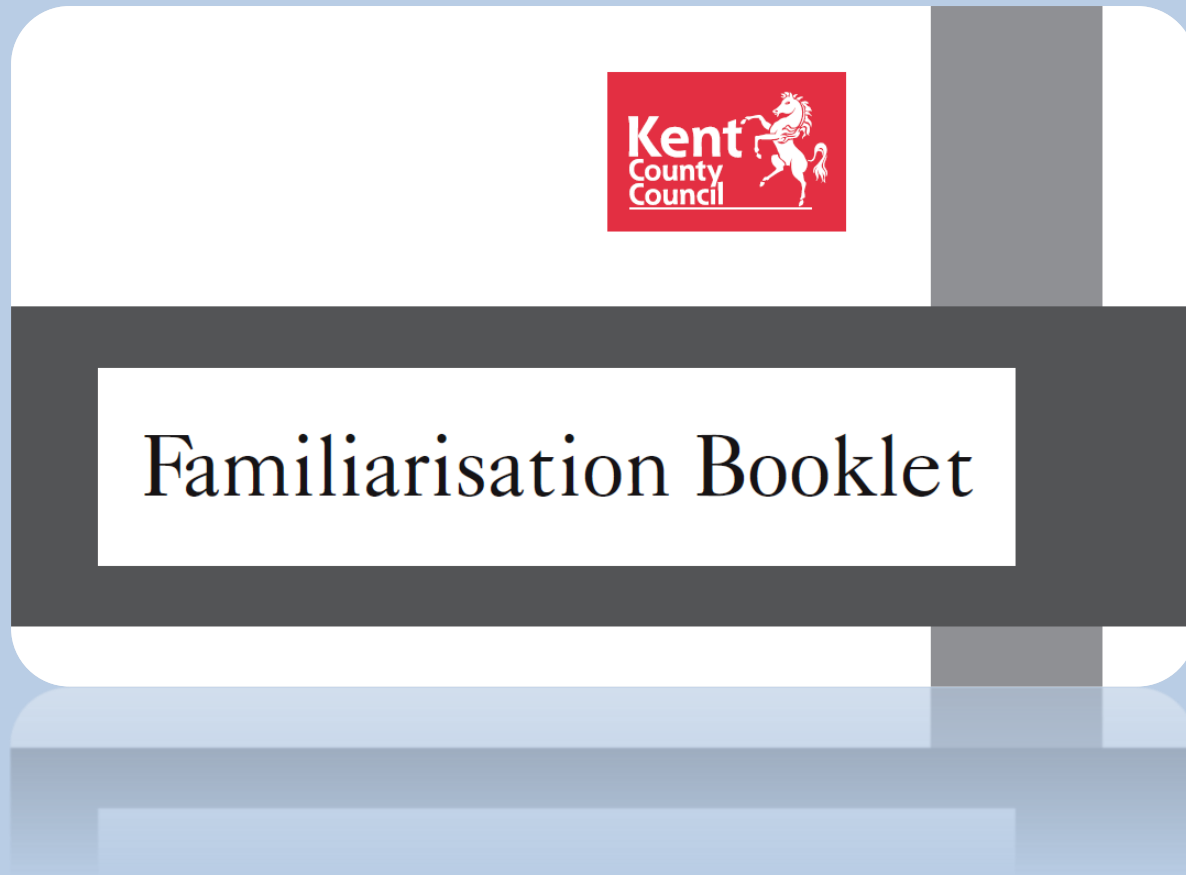


- There is also a 40-minute writing task which is not marked and does not impact on the standardised score. This provides evidence for further consideration in the event of a headteacher appeal.

How does it work?

- The tests are in multiple-choice format, and children's answer sheets are machine marked.
- Test results are standardised, giving a score between 69 and 141 for each paper.
- Standardisation references the average performance, putting different tests on a common scale. It takes account of each child's age and allows the use of 3 scores together to consider 'overall ability'.

Grammar School

In order to consider a grammar school your child must take part in PESE. It is not possible to name a grammar school on the Secondary School Application Form if you don't.

What do I need to do? When do I need to do it?

- Register for the tests – 1 June - 1 July 2026
- www.kent.gov.uk/ola
- Tests Taken – Thursday 10th September 2026
- Results emailed / posted to parents – Thursday 15th October 2026
- National SCAF deadline – end of October 2026

Weald Grammar Assessment

- The Weald Grammar Assessment is an additional, optional opportunity for girls to demonstrate grammar school suitability for entry to Weald of Kent Grammar School.
- Registration runs from Monday 1st June to Friday 10th July.
- Parents must register directly with the school, with the registration form available on the school website or from the school office.
- The Assessment will take place on Saturday 12th September at Weald of Kent Grammar School.
- The Assessment will include:
 - Paper 1: English (40 minutes) & verbal reasoning (20 minutes)
 - Paper 2: Maths (40 minutes) & non-verbal reasoning (20 minutes)

The Medway Test

- Some parents occasionally apply for the Medway Test. The registration for this closes on Friday 12th June 2026.
- If you do not live in Medway or close to its boundary, it is unlikely your child will be offered a grammar school place in Medway, even if your child passes the Medway Test.
- All grammar schools in Medway are oversubscribed and places are mainly allocated on how far your child lives from the school. Places are not allocated based on test score.
