Bonfire Night Produce a detailed poster explaining how children can stay safe during Bonfire Night celebrations. Make sure you are writing to your target audience. Think about how you would make your poster appealing to a child.	Written addition - pages 1 & 2	5 th November
Life in a Maya City Research what buildings were found in a Maya city (e.g. pyramids, temples, ball courts, palaces, houses). Get creative using LEGO, junk modelling or drawing create your own Maya city. Label each part and write a few sentences about its purpose.	Written addition - page 3	12 th November
Science - create a classification key for animals Start by choosing 4-6 animals. Then create a classification key that sorts the animals you have chosen (e.g. does it have feathers? Yes or no) You can decide to draw it on paper or make it digitally.	Written subtraction - pages 4 & 5	19 th November
Why the Amazon Matters - Create an eye-catching poster, fact file, or infographic that answers this question - Why is the Amazon Rainforest important to the whole world? You should include: 1. A labelled map showing where the Amazon Rainforest is 2. At least five key facts about how it helps the planet (e.g. oxygen, biodiversity, medicine, water cycle, climate) 3. One paragraph explaining what happens when trees are cut down and how that affects us 4. A creative element - a drawing, collage, or symbols (trees, Earth, animals etc)	Written subtraction - pages 6 & 7	26 th November
