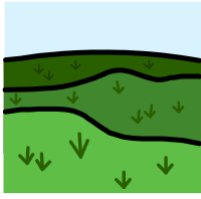
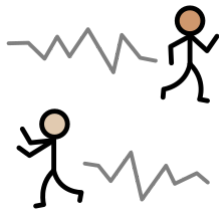

summoned

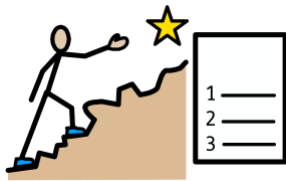
to call or notify to appear for a particular purpose

queasy

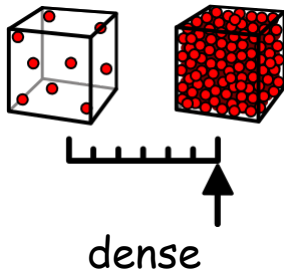
feeling sick to one's stomach
