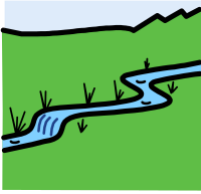


Rivers



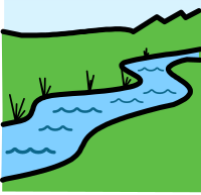
mountain

A mountain range is a chain of mountains that are very close together.



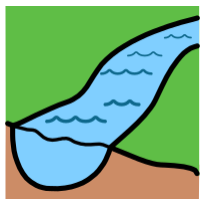
stream

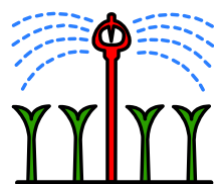
monsoon

Some very hot countries have a rainy season called a monsoon.



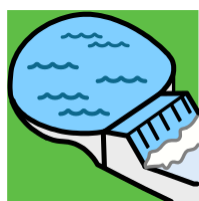
glacier

A glacier is a huge stretch of ice that is moving very slowly.



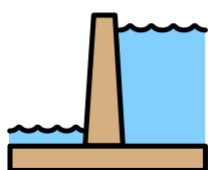
irrigation

dam

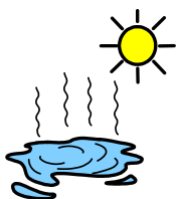
A dam is a barrier that blocks flowing water or sends the water in a different direction.

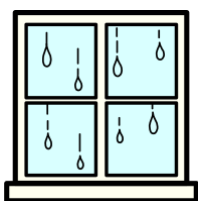
hydro-electric
power

Hydro-electric power is a type of renewable energy that uses the power of moving water to generate electricity.



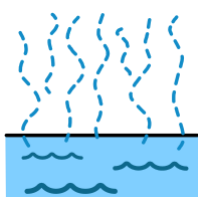
evaporation

The sun heats the water on the surface of the earth, causing the water to turn from liquid to a gas. This process is called evaporation.



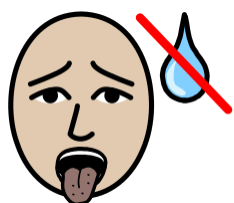
condensation
