

Dividing by 8

- 1 a) Pegs are packed into packs of 8.

There are 24 pegs.



How many packs can you make?

$$\square \div \square = \square$$

You can make $\square$ packs of pegs.

- b) A lorry has 8 wheels.

How many lorries are there?

$$\square \div \square = \square$$

There are $\square$ lorries.



- 2 8 balls are shared equally between 8 cats.

How many balls does each cat get?

- 3 Millie is holding some octagons.

An octagon has 8 sides. There are 48 sides in total.

How many octagons does she have?

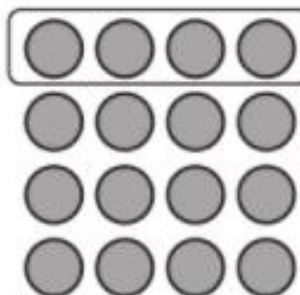
$$\square \div \square = \square$$

Millie has $\square$ octagons.

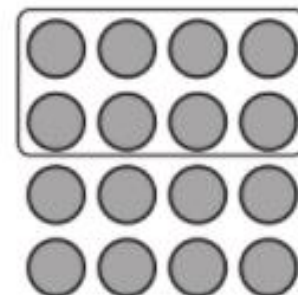


- 4 Use the diagrams to help you work out the divisions.
