

Dividing by 4

- 1 a) Jelly beans are shared equally between 4 children.

How many beans does each child get?



$$\square \div \square = \square$$

- b) Apples are packed into boxes of 4.

How many boxes of apples can be made?

$\square$ boxes of apples can be made.

- 2 Liam counts 20 cat legs.

How many cats are there?

There are $\square$ cats.

- 3 Use the array to work out $32 \div 4$.

$$32 \div 4 = \square$$



- 4 28 biscuits are shared equally between 4 plates.



How many biscuits are there on each plate?

- 5 A magazine costs £4.

How many magazines can Richard buy with this note?
