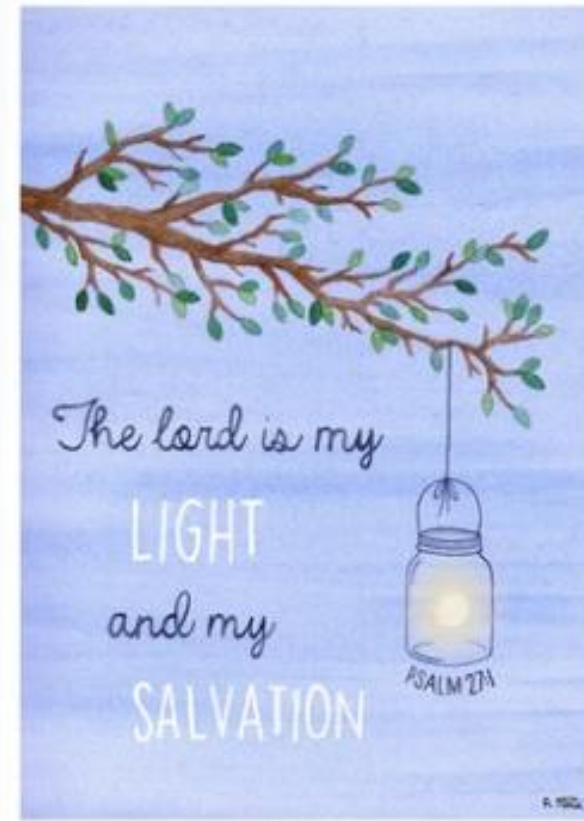
What does 'The Grace' teach Christians about the Trinity?

- Christians believe that God, through the Holy Spirit is with each person wherever they are. So even when they are eating their breakfast or on holiday, God is there with them.
- 'The Grace' is a prayer and blessing that many Christians use when gathered together with other believers. They often say it together at the beginning or end of a meeting.
- It comes from 2 Corinthians 13:14 and was part of a letter Paul wrote to the people living in Corinth.
