The process of building or creating something again that has been damaged or destroyed.



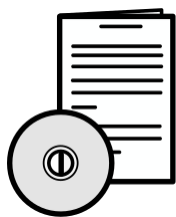
merchant

A building or store room for storing threshed grain or farm feed.

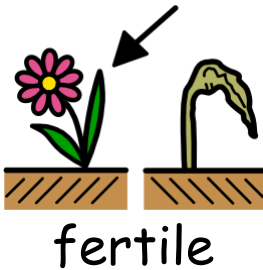
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A Civilisation is a group of people with their own languages and way of life.
