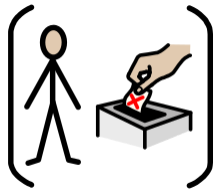
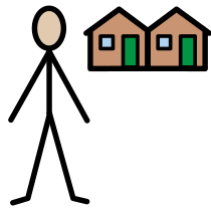


## Ancient Greece



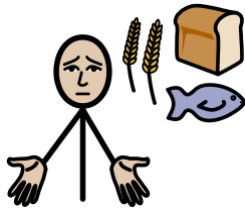
Democracy

A citizen is someone who lives in a particular area, or belongs to a country such as the United Kingdom.



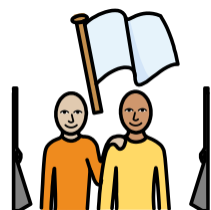
starve

To enslave someone is to force that person to work for no pay, to obey commands, and to lose his or her freedom.



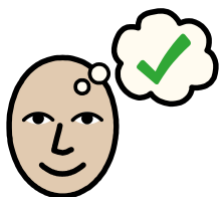
sculptures

philosophers

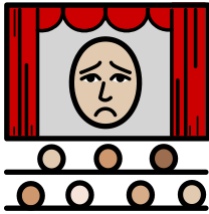
Greek philosophers were "seekers and lovers of wisdom"

A school.



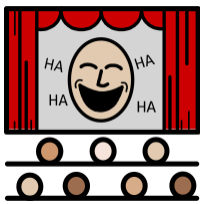
tragedy
