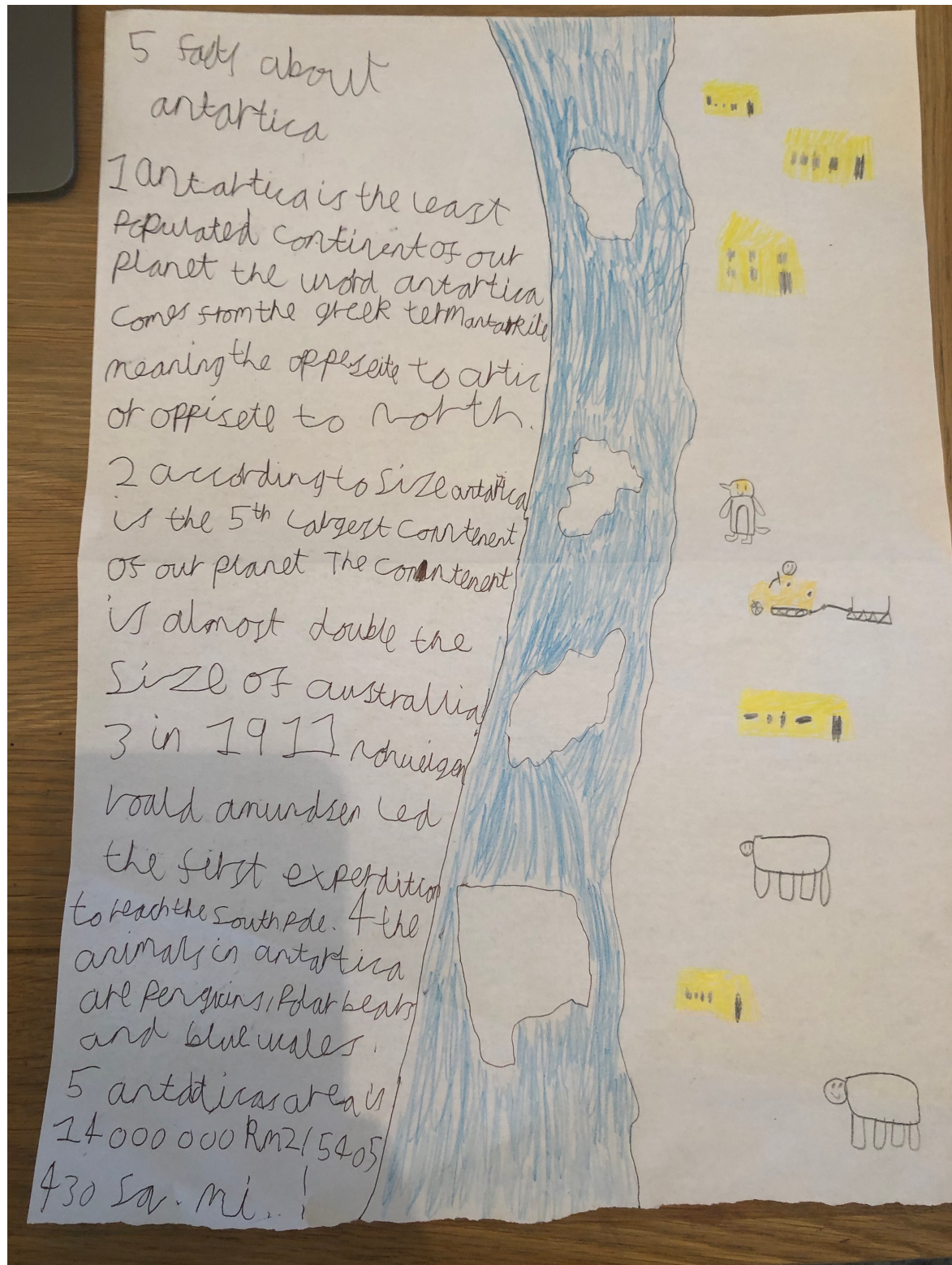

5 Facts on Antarctica



Antarctica is located at the South Pole and is surrounded by the Southern Ocean.

Over 98% of Antarctica is covered by ice.

No humans live in Antarctica permanently. However, about 1,000 to 5,000 people live through the year at the science stations in Antarctica.

Emperor penguins are only found in Antarctica.
They breed and raise their young there.

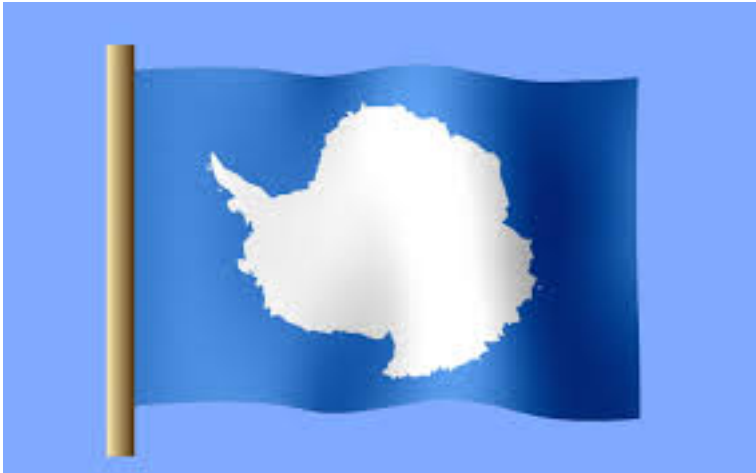


Antarctica is the coldest continent of our planet.
The coldest air temperature ever measured in Antarctica was -89.2°C at Vostok Station in 1983.

There are 2 active volcanoes in Antarctica.

Antarctica contains more than 90% of the world's ice and more than 90% of our planet's fresh water.
